Dear Majority Leader Schumer, Minority Leader McConnell, Speaker Pelosi and Minority Leader McCarthy:

The undersigned over 200 national, state, and local organizations endorse the passing and funding of the Full-Service Community Schools Expansion Act of 2020 and the inclusion of full-service community schools as an allowable use of funding for public schools and school districts in future COVID-19 relief packages.

The time is now for a significant investment in community schools. Currently, the federal Full-Service Community Schools program is funded at \$30 million supporting 54 communities, but this amount falls far short of the need and demand for this strategy from communities who want to create community schools both to stabilize families that have been most severely impacted during the pandemic and to accelerate learning beyond. The Full-Service Community Schools Expansion Act (S. 4865) introduced in November 2020 and that will be reintroduced this week, would meet this need and demand with a significant federal investment in community schools of \$500 million for FY 2021 and increasing to \$1 billion by FY 2025.

This funding would enable Congress to direct limited resources to the schools and communities where at least 40% of the students qualify for free and reduced-price lunch or are identified by the state as in need of additional support, to optimize the coordination of resources that meet family's basic needs, support the mental health of students, accelerate learning, and support the families' re-entry into the workforce.

Community schools are an effective, <u>evidence-based strategy for school improvement</u> and we can <u>point to</u> several examples of the power of community schools to transform high-poverty, low-performing schools into thriving schools including a recent <u>RAND study of NYC's community schools</u>. They are also a smart investment: the coordination of resources at both the school and system levels translates to <u>a return on investment</u> of over \$7 for every \$1 invested in a Coordinator's salary.

Throughout the pandemic, individual community schools and systems of community schools were able to mobilize quickly and effectively to support the social, emotional, physical, and learning needs of students and their families. Community schools are demonstrating, from Florida and North Carolina to New York and elsewhere, how their strong relationships, relational trust, agility, and coordination are helping schools and their communities better respond to and recover from the pandemic. As a result, we urge Congress to include full-service community schools as an allowable use of funding for schools and districts in future COVID-19 relief packages, reinforcing President Biden's call to expand community schools through funding in his American Rescue Plan.

Because federal funding for community schools is currently so small compared to the level of demand in the field, the U.S. Department of Education routinely turns down highly ranked, near-perfect score applications, therefore squandering the opportunity to support communities that are committed and ready to apply this strategy to advance educational equity. Passing and funding the Full-Service Community Schools Expansion Act would enable hundreds of these communities to coordinate the assets of their schools, families, and community partners for students' immediate and long-term success.

We have an opportunity to learn from the experiences of students, families and educators during the pandemic and carve a bold vision for public education going forward. This bold vision ensures that all students have access to the foundational supports necessary for learning to address their physical, social, and emotional needs; that they have enriching, high-quality instruction, access to a full curriculum including the arts, social sciences, foreign language, civic education, and Advanced Placement courses, and to out-of-school time opportunities; and that their families and communities are actively engaged as important partners in their learning and well-being. Community schools offers a time-tested, effective, collaborative, hyper-local, and evidence-based strategy to implement and help achieve this vision. We urge you to pass and fund the Full-Service Community Schools Expansion Act as soon as possible, and to include full-service community schools as an allowable use of funding in future COVID-19 relief packages, to give millions of students the opportunity to be supported and successful in school, and to set a bold vision of public education for all our schools in the country.
